REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION**

**MUSIC PERFORMANCE, WIND AND PERCUSSION INSTRUMENTS  
FIRST CYCLE (BACHELOR'S) STUDIES**

The Group of Wind and Percussion Instruments includes the following specialisations: Baritone, Euphonium, Bassoon, Flute, Clarinet, Cornet, Percussion, Oboe, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Tube, and French Horn.

The entrance examination consists of two parts: music performance and an admission interview based on questions related to the chosen study programme.

**I. Performing music with a selected instrument.** The programme consists of:

1. a large-scale piece (Movement I or Movements II and III),
2. two plays of a different character (cantilena and virtuoso);
3. evaluating scales-playing skills and sight-reading skills.

**II. The interview based on questions related to the chosen study programme. Areas of the questions:**

1. Discussion of the works performed during the examination - the composers; the period when the works were composed and other relevant circumstances; references occurring in the text; a basic analysis of the performance.
2. Knowledge of the specialisation instrument: its history, performers, major literature sources related to the art and teaching of the selected instrument.
3. Music life in Lithuania: composers, performers, orchestras and chamber ensembles.
