Requirements for entrants*	Recognition of the earlier studies
Admission to the second cycle study programme <i>Film Art</i> is open to people with a bachelor's or equivalent qualificational degree.  Graduates with a non-film bachelor's or equivalent degree must submit documents proving at least one year's professional experience in the chosen specialisation (professional portfolio).  The structure of the competitive score consists of the assessment of the entrance exam, assessment of the motivational interview on the issues of the chosen study programme and the average of the marks indicated in the bachelor's study diploma supplement (appendix).
