### THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION THE FIRST (BACHELOR) CYCLE OF STUDIES

#### MUSIC STUDIES: ELECTRONIC MUSIC

The entrance examination consists of three parts: Presentation of Composition Works, Admission Interview, and Musical Knowledge Test.

##### 1. Presentation of Composed Works

Recordings of three works for electronic and/or acoustic instruments are submitted for the examination. The works may be accompanied by video material. At least one of the works submitted for the examination must be written in score.

A PDF file (name\_lastname\_work\_titles.pdf) with active links to the compositions and scores must be sent by e-mail [kompozicija.ba@lmta.lt](mailto:kompozicija.ba@lmta.lt) no later than 10 days prior to the start of the entrance examination.

The cover letter must include the sender's name, last name, LAMA BPO registration number, contact information, the study programme, and specialisation.

##### 2. Admission Interview

During the admission interview, the applicant has to answer orally the questions related to the chosen study programme in order to demonstrate the applicant's motivation to study the chosen specialisation. The topics of the interview are related to the repertoire performed during the entrance examination, the musical context, and motivation and are as follows: the principles and techniques of composing; the history and practice of the modern music; the motivation for choosing the studies.

##### 3. Musical Knowledge Test

This written examination tests the applicant's ear training and knowledge of music theory and history.
